Activity around medical center on evening of Dec. 9 – Employees, physicians, volunteers and their families will attend a preview event of the new Magnolia Tower for our on the evening of Dec. 9. This provides those of us who work at the medical center, and our families, an opportunity to see the new tower and how it is coming along. We expect more vehicle and pedestrian traffic during this event. Most guests will park in the parking structure and immediately around the medical center. While this event is exclusively for our employees, volunteers and the physicians on our medical staff, we will provide a community event in conjunction with our grand opening of the new patient tower in 2012. We will keep you posted as these plans progress.



Landscaping to continue in December – Landscaping around the Magnolia Tower began in November and will continue this month and into the new year. We're about half done with placing the main irrigation lines. In December we'll continue this work in addition to planting many trees.

Equipment in the Magnolia Tower – Surgical lights and equipment boom installation will continue in December in the Surgery Center. On the fourth floor – our Nettleton Mother & Baby Care Center – we will begin installation of exam lights in Labor & Delivery and surgical lights in the C-section rooms. With the second and fifth floors substantially complete, we will continue finalizing the fourth floor and third floors. Flooring and cabinetry installation is underway throughout the tower, and crews will continue miscellaneous interior framing, dry walling and painting, and mechanical, electrical, and plumbing work. No major site or street work is planned.
