In addition to the September newsletter we sent earlier this month, we have this information about construction.

Sixth Avenue pedestrian access to temporarily close, lot entrance to close

Pedestrian access on Sixth Avenue between Arcadian and Magnolia Avenues will close for about three weeks due to a project scheduled to start Monday, Sept. 12. The street will remain open to vehicles, however large equipment will be on site. This process is not expected to be noisy. The pedestrian detour for Sixth Avenue is Seventh Avenue to Magnolia and back to Sixth. This project will create a meandering (curvy) sidewalk further away from the roadway. This also creates a landscaped frontage area. This is a City of Chico project, and Enloe is completing this portion of the work. The City will later continue the work along more blocks of Sixth Avenue. As part of this month's project, the Sixth Avenue entry to the parking lot behind Enloe's Human Resources building at Sixth and Magnolia will permanently close.
