The centerpiece of the New Beginning at Enloe Medical Center is the Enloe Century Project. This is one of the most significant projects in the history of our community.

Through the Enloe Century Project, Enloe Medical Center will be transformed by the construction of a new five-story patient tower and a single-story surgery and emergency centers, doubling the capacity of our current hospital. Upon completion there will be 235 single patient rooms with a capacity of up to 321 patient beds.

The Enloe Century Project is designed for 21st century health care to meet the needs of our growing region. It will provide for interdisciplinary teams of physicians using the latest and best medical equipment, and for patient-centered care that considers all aspects of the individual's healing. The goals of the Enloe Century Project are:

- To build an attractive, comfortable, nurturing and efficient hospital that creates a positive patient centered Planetree healing environment for our patients.
- To recruit and retain outstanding physicians, nurses and technical staff by providing a hospital that is commensurate with their talents and skills.
- To provide the latest in medical technology and treatment.
- To encourage and support the highest quality of clinical staff possible for our community.
- To ensure that the highest quality medicine is practiced in partnership with every patient.





Enloe Century Project will focus on both medical enhancements and patient comfort. Major components of the construction will provide:

- Private patient rooms with the potential to expand to semi-private rooms
- Mediterranean design and touches with enhanced landscaping
- Planetree architectural design conducive to health and healing
- Steve and Kathy Nettleton Mother & Baby Care Center, dedicating the fourth floor to maternity services
- A new emergency center that triples the original size, with a dedicated emergency X-ray and CT-scan room
- 12 new enlarged and enhanced surgical suites that double the surgical capacity
- Two new 12-bed intensive care units for cardiovascular and neurological patients
- Larger medical/surgical units designed to accommodate Planetree activities, interdisciplinary teams of physicians and clinical staff along with state-of-the art equipment
- A new and significantly larger main entrance with a reception area, lounge, garden café, meditation room and gift shop
- A museum highlighting more than ninety-five years of service
- Dedicated surgery and emergency street entrances, reception areas and lounges
- An emphasis on privacy and confidentiality including two physician/ patient/family consultation rooms
- Separate elevators for patients and the public
- Comfortable family lounges on the upper floors
- A neighborhood friendly designed, four-level, three story parking structure for employees and physicians
- Expanded patient and visitor parking along 5th Avenue
- Adjacent park for patients, families, employees, physicians, volunteers and neighbors to enjoy

The building construction estimated time of completion is 2011 and will cost approximately \$155 million. The cost includes the new hospital, medical equipment, information systems, high efficiency cooling, heating and emergency power systems, parking structure, furnishings and landscaping.
