

Enloe Foundation Scholarships Descriptions and Requirements

Janis Kay Anderson Graduate Nursing Scholarship

Janis Kay Anderson always dreamed of becoming a nurse. During her youth, she read all the Sue Barton Student Nurse books. Janis's nursing career was from 1975 to 1996 in the ICU/CCU of Chico Community Hospital and Enloe Medical Center. Janis, a skilled and compassionate clinician, was a charge nurse and eventually became a S.W.A.T. nurse. Well respected and known for her calm leadership, wide smile and professional skills, Janis's love of nursing gently lifted the hearts of her patients and her fellow nurses.

Established in Janis's memory by her husband Brian Anderson, this scholarship is to financially support nurses that have the same passion for nursing that Janis possessed.

Fund Allocation:

One (1) one thousand dollar (\$1,000) scholarship may be distributed once a year from the Janis Kay Anderson Graduate Nursing Scholarship Fund.

Eligibility:

Applicants must be current employees in good standing at Enloe Medical Center. Must be accepted or enrolled into the Master of Science in Nursing Program at CSU, Chico or other eligible nursing educational institution. Nursing professionals from all fields may apply.

Recipient Responsibilities:

Applicant is required to give one presentation on the nursing profession to the Butte County Juvenile Hall. Brian Anderson, the scholarship sponsor, will work with the applicant to arrange this speaking engagement.

Application Requirements:

Application form, written cover letter, proof of enrollment, or letter of acceptance into the Master of Science Graduate Nursing program at CSU, Chico. Letter of recommendation by supervisor is required.

Enloe Golf Tournament Nursing Scholarship

The Enloe Foundation Golf Tournament Committee created this scholarship in 1999, designed to encourage and enhance the educational advancement of our nursing staff. Current nursing staff pursuing further education, along with any Enloe employees who are pursuing a degree in nursing, are encouraged to apply.

Fund Allocation:

Two (2) one thousand dollar (\$1,000) scholarships may be distributed each year from the Enloe Golf Tournament Nursing Scholarship fund.

Eligibility:

Applicants for this continuing education scholarship must be current employees in good standing at Enloe Medical Center, and actively pursuing nursing education.

Application Requirements:

Application form along with documentation of the type of nursing education this money will be used towards is required. For example: proof of enrollment, letter of acceptance, application for CE seminar. Letter of recommendation by supervisor is required.

Men's Associates Enloe Medical Center Employee Scholarship Fund

The Enloe Men's Associates was created in 1966 predating even Enloe Hospital as a private not-for-profit organization. The purpose of the Men's Associates was to support and promote the programs of Enloe Medical Center through education, advocacy, fund raising and service. For the last 41 years, they have conducted their mission with dignity and pride having a significant impact on Enloe Medical Center and the community. As of July 1, 2007, the Men's Associates will be merged into the Enloe Partners support group and cease to exist. To honor the legacy of this cherished group of supporters and volunteers, the Men's Associates Enloe Medical Center Employee Scholarship Fund was created out of their commitment and the balance of the Men's Associates Fund.

Fund Allocation:

Two (2) five hundred dollar (\$500) scholarships may be distributed each year from the Men's Associates Enloe Medical Center Employee Scholarship Fund.

Eligibility:

All Enloe Medical Center employees in good standing from all fields are eligible to apply. The Men's Associates Enloe Medical Center Employee Scholarship Fund will be utilized to fund continuing education related to current employment at a conference, educational institution or on-line seminar.

Recipient Responsibilities:

Recipients of the Men's Associates Enloe Medical Center Scholarship may be asked to submit a report and speak about their educational experience to appropriate groups.

Application Requirements:

Enloe Foundation Scholarship application and letter of recommendation by supervisor is required.

Nurses' Day Scholarship Awards

The Enloe Nurses Day Scholarships Award was established in 2000 to encourage and enhance the educational advancement of our nursing staff. These scholarships have been established in memory of the Enloe Medical Center Nurses who have passed away. Scholarships are awarded to one nursing student attending or intending to enroll at California State University, Chico, and two nursing students attending or intending to enroll at Butte College.

Fund Allocation:

One (1) one thousand dollar (\$1,000) scholarship to attend California State University, Chico and two (2) five hundred (\$500) scholarships to attend Butte College may be distributed each year from the Nurses' Day Scholarship Fund.

Eligibility:

Applicants for this scholarship must be current employees in good standing at Enloe Medical Center, and actively pursuing nursing education.

Application Requirements:

The applicant must be currently enrolled or show a letter of acceptance in the aforementioned nursing programs. Enloe Foundation Scholarship application and letter of recommendation by supervisor is required.

Claudine O. Bell and Helen L. Head Nursing Scholarship

Claudine O. Bell and Helen L. Head have fond memories of Enloe Hospital and the nursing care their family has received over the years. From N.T. Enloe removing Claudine's appendix in 1920 at the age of 14, to the caring doctors and nurses that attended to Helen's husband, Ray Walter Head in 1970 after his tragic accident, along with the care that continues to be provided today, Claudine and Helen have always appreciated the skill and compassion of Enloe Medical Center's staff.

In honor and loving memory of Claudine and Helen's favorite cousins, Eleanor and Margaret Dawson, who were both nurses, they established the Claudine O. Bell and Helen L. Head Nursing Scholarship in 2008.

Fund Allocation:

One (1) two thousand five hundred dollar (\$2,500) scholarship may be distributed once a year from the Claudine O. Bell and Helen L. Head Nursing Scholarship.

Eligibility:

The scholarship winner must be an employee of Enloe Medical Center in good standing. Must have a 3.0 grade point average. Must be accepted or enrolled in California State University, Chico, to become a Registered Nurse or receive a Bachelors of Science in nursing degree. Nursing professionals from all fields may apply.

Recipient Responsibilities:

As requested by Enloe Foundation, the scholarship recipient may be asked to submit a report and/or speak about their educational experience to appropriate groups.

Application Requirements:

Application form, written cover letter, proof of enrollment and GPA, or letter of acceptance into the Master of Science Graduate Nursing program at CSU, Chico. Letter of recommendation by supervisor is required.

Peggy Steel Nursing Scholarship

A local long-time resident who greatly appreciated the nursing care while a patient at Enloe Medical Center, and who recognizes the vital role that nurses provide in a hospital setting, funded this scholarship program in 2008. It is designed to encourage and enhance the educational opportunities and advancement of our nursing staff. The donor also wishes this scholarship to encourage potential and practical nurses to stay in the area to pursue their education, and to commit to local professional nursing pursuits.

Fund Allocation:

Three (3) one thousand dollar (\$1,000) scholarships may be distributed each year from the Peggy Steel Nursing Scholarship.

Eligibility:

Current nursing staff that is pursuing further education or any Enloe employee who is pursuing a degree in nursing is encouraged to apply. Applicants for this scholarship must be current employees in good standing at Enloe Medical Center, and have a stated desire to stay local pursuing their education and professional nursing career.

Application Requirements:

A completed application form is required for this scholarship, along with documentation of the type of nursing education this money will be used toward. For example: application, proof of enrollment and/or letter of acceptance. Letter of recommendation by supervisor is required.

Enloe Employee Scholarship

Established in October of 2008, the Enloe Employee Scholarship is for Enloe employees pursuing continuing education in their chosen field.

Fund Allocation:

Up to four (4) five hundred dollar (\$500) scholarships may be distributed each year from the Enloe Employee Scholarship Fund.

Eligibility:

All Enloe Medical Center employees in good standing from all fields are eligible to apply. The Enloe Employee Scholarship Fund will be utilized to fund continuing education related to their current employment for the employee at a conference, educational institution or on-line seminar.

Recipient Responsibilities:

Recipients of the Enloe Medical Center Employee Scholarship may be asked to submit a report and/or speak about their educational experience to appropriate groups.

Application Requirements:

Enloe Foundation Scholarship application form and letter of recommendation by supervisor is required.
