Locations:	Esplanade Campus Enloe Rehabilitation Center Enloe Regional Cancer Center Lassen Building Enloe Prompt Care (Bruce Road and Cohasset Road)
Responsible to:	The designated liaison on-site for volunteers, or manager on duty responsible for area in which the musician is performing.
