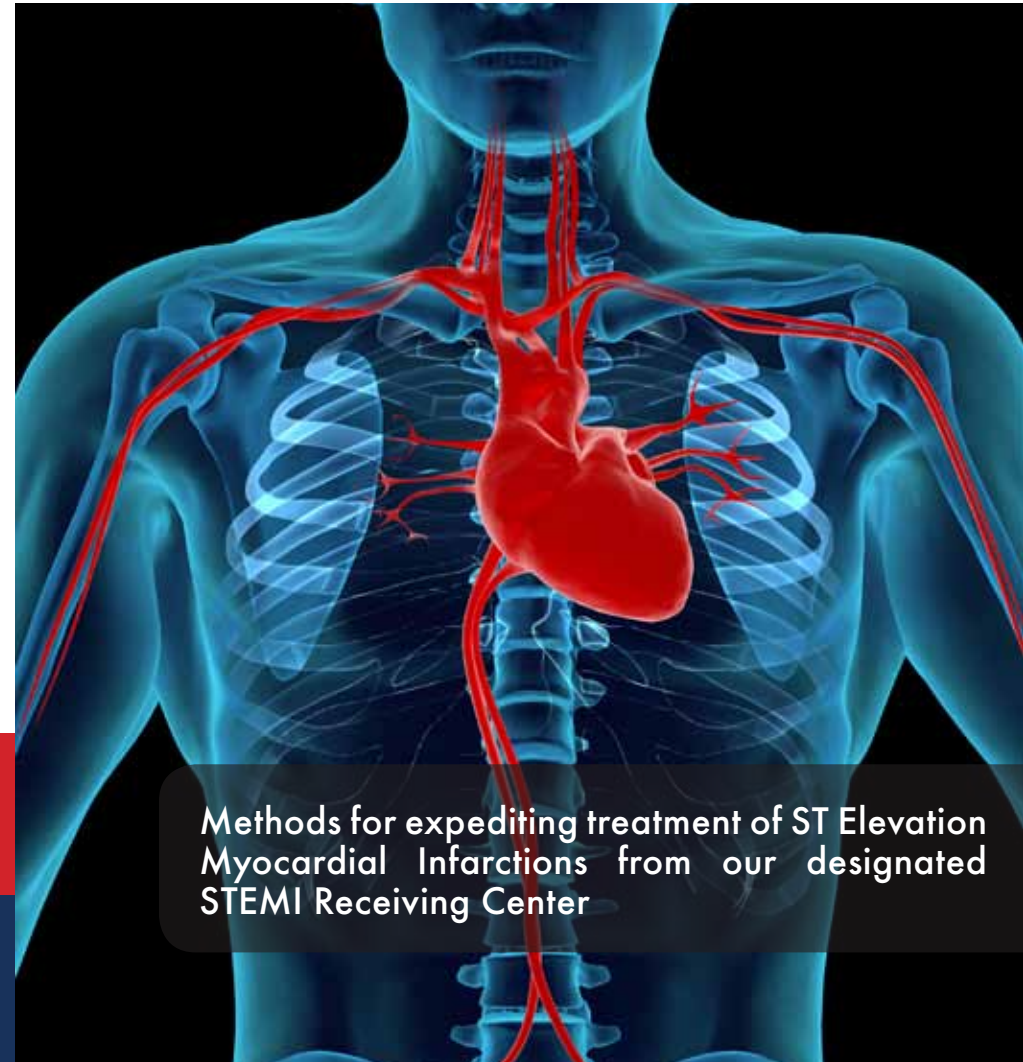

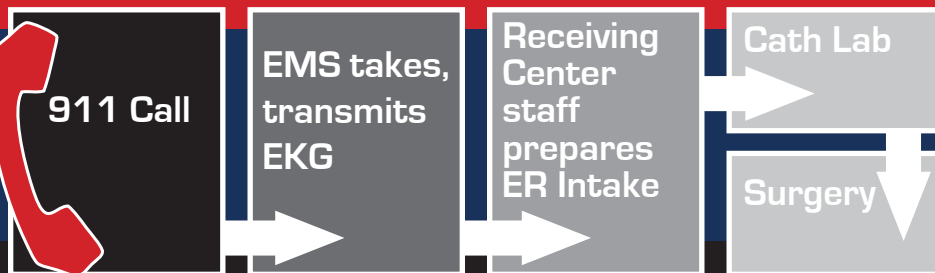

Enloe Medical Center was the first hospital between the Roseville and the Oregon border to be designated as a STEMI Receiving Center. Thanks to coordinated efforts between paramedics and acute-care personnel, this system of response to acute coronary incidents has yielded positive outcomes across the country.

What is the STEMI Response?

The process commences when the ambulance service or fire department arrives on the scene of the 9-1-1 call or at another area hospital. Paramedics perform an EKG and transmit the results to the STEMI Receiving Center.

There, a team of physicians, nurses and technicians begins to review the data. This response team creates a treatment plan before the patient arrives at the hospital. This allows the patient to go directly to the Catheterization Lab or receive care in the Emergency Department, based on the condition of the patient.

The goal is to have a patient receiving comprehensive treatment within 90 minutes of patients' arrival – a timeframe known as the Door-to-Balloon Golden Rule, because angioplasty is a common procedure for restoring blood flow in the blocked arteries responsible for STEMI.
